## NOTICE

The State of Arizona recently passed a new law allowing for the sale and use of specific consumer fireworks. House Bill # 2246 takes effect December 1, 2010. This bill allows Incorporated cities and towns to regulate the “use” of those consumer fireworks. Therefore the City of Kingman has passed an ordinance prohibiting the “use,ignition or discharge” of those consumer fireworks with specific penalties to be levied against anyone violating this ordinance. The City of Kingman Ordinance also takes effect December 1, 2010. The City of Kingman ordinance does allow for the “sale” of consumer fireworks, but prohibits their “use”. Anyone choosing to sell or distribute “Consumer fireworks” shall abide by strict rules spelled out in the ordinance.

- Signs are required to be placed by each cash register and in each area where fireworks are displayed for sale.
- Signage requirements: Each sign shall be 8 1/2 x 11 inches in size with at least a 22 font size in red. We have attached a copy of the exact wording to be used on the signs. Feel free to copy the sample sign.
- It is not illegal to sell these consumer fireworks, however it is illegal to use them in the city limits of Kingman.
- Regular compliance inspections will be conducted throughout the year to insure complete compliance with the ordinance. Failure to comply with these rules is a Class 3 Misdemeanor criminal offense.
