Residential Structure Fire

Kingman-Wednesday at 12:33 p.m., The Kingman Fire Department was dispatched for report of a structure fire located at 1502 Broadway Street. Two Paramedic Engines and the on duty Battalion Chief responded with the initial dispatch. A third engine was

dispatched as responding units reported that smoke and flames could be seen in the area. Upon the first engine's arrival they reported a well involved single story residence with a partial roof collapse. Fire personnel were able to confine the fire to the structure of origin. The residence was occupied by an adult female who was not home at the time of the fire. Kingman Fire Department Fire Investigators determined the fire was unintentional and started in a crawl space under the living room floor. The fire caused significant damage to the residence and dollar loss figures are approximately \$20,000. The property was insured. Unfortunately, four family pets (dogs) died in the fire.
